An iPhone functions as a Camera Phone including Text Messaging and Visual voice mail, a Portable media Player and an Internet client with E-Mail, Web Browsing and WIFI connectivity. The user interface is built around the device's multi touch screen, including a virtual keyboard rather than a physical one. Third party applications are available

from the app store, which launched in mid 2008 and now has well over 300,000 apps approved by Apple. These apps have diverse functionalities, including games, references GPS navigation, Social

Networking, and advertising for television shows, films, and celebrities.



iPhone Generations

There are four Generation of iPhone models, and they were accompanied by four major releases of iOS formerly iPhone OS. The Original iPhone established design precedents like screen size and button

placement that have persisted through all models. The iPhone 3G added 3G cellular network capabilities and A-GPS location. The iPhone 3GS added a Compass, faster processor, and

higher resolution camera, including video. The iPhone 4 has two cameras for Face Time video calling and a higher-resolution display. It was released on June 24, 2010.

iPad

The **ipad** is a Tablet computer designed and developed by Apple. It is particularly marketed as a platform for audio and visual media such as books, periodicals, movies, music, and games, as well as web content. At about 1.5 pounds 680 grams, its size and weight are

between those of most contemporary Smart phones and Lap top computers. Apple released the iPad in April 2010 and sold 3 million of the devices in 80 days.

Internet, load and stream media, and install software. Some models also have a 3G wireless data connection which can connect to GSM 3G data networks. The device is managed and

Synced by iTunes on a personal computer via USB cable.

commentary or news on a particular subject; others function as more personal online diaries. A typical blog combines text, images, and links to other blogs, web pages, and other media related to its topic. The ability of readers to

leave comments in an interactive format is an important part of many blogs. Most blogs are primarily textual, although some focus on art art blog, photographs photo blog, videos video blog, music MP3 blog, and audio Pod



Xbox 360

The Xbox 360 is the second video game console produced by Microsoft, and the successor to the Xbox. The Xbox 360 competes with Sony's PlayStation 3 and Nintendo Wii as part of the seventh generation of video game consoles. Some major features of the Xbox 360 are its integrated Xbox Live service that allows players to compete online, download arcade games, game demos, trailers, TV shows, music and movies and its Windows Media player multimedia capabilities. The Xbox 360 also offers region specific access to third-party media streaming services such as Netflix and ESPN in the USA or Sky Player in the UK.
